Short description of activities provided under sub-program in the reporting period Within the framework of VET (vocational education teachers) state development program provided by LEPL National Center for Teacher Professional Development, vocational schools teacher trainings were held in September 2016 inclusive in 4 main areas: Pedagogical course; Modular teaching - "competence-based assessment in modular vocational education programs"; Inclusive vocational education: In-service vocational training.

The VET pedagogical course has been elaborated in collaboration with UNDP which consists of 5 training-modules. **The pedagogical course Module I** - "Individual peculiarities of students in vocational education" was held in **5 vocational schools** (8 groups) . In total **156 teachers** have been trained.

The pedagogical course Module II - "Positive learning environment in vocational education" was held in **5 vocational schools** (8 groups) . In total **156 teachers** have been trained.

The pedagogical course Module IV - "Planning of teaching process and effective teaching strategies" (40 hr) was held in 3 **vocational schools**. Total of **132 teachers have been trained**.

Together with MCA, the VET needs analysis was conducted (Teacher Survey). The survey participants were 230 teachers from different public colleges. Ultimately, the training module (4 meeting-seminars) "Competency-based assessment in modular vocational education programs" was developed and approved and trainer training held for evaluation the module and discussion of the recommendations thereto. Pursuant to the recommendations of the National Center for Education Quality Enhancement, seven qualified trainer-consultants were selected. On June 15-16-17 the module was piloted in TPDC to 15 different college teachers.

Training-module in modular teaching- "Competence based assessment in modular vocational education programs" was held in 24 vocational schools (33 groups); Total of 678 teachers has been trained;

In collaboration with MCA, VET self-assessment questionnaire has been developed that helps to assess teachers needs. The questionnaire has been filled out by **831 teachers** and results analyzed.

The training: "Modular teaching issues for VET".

In collaboration with the National Center for Education Quality Enhancement and MCA, the training module "Modular teaching issues for VET" has been developed.

The trainers, who were selected under the recommendation of the National Center for Educational Quality Enhancement, were provided with trainer trainings. The trainers developed a working material. The training was conducted in **16 vocational schools** (19 groups) and **407 teachers trained**.

The teacher training in inclusive vocational education; the training titled: "Individual approaches to SEN vocational students and vocational testing _ part 2" (10 hr) has been provided since May 2016 in **16 public colleges** (20 groups) and **316 teachers trained;**

Teacher In-service Trainings: under the program, a number of institutions, enterprises and teachers / experts have been identified to plan trainings in 26 directions to be introduced in the future. The in-service trainings were organized and training activities provided by expert-facilitators. The list of the field expert-facilitators, who developed the modular programs to be adopted, has been provided by the National Center for Educational Quality Enhancement.

In an effort to develop VET international mobility program, a situational analysis was carried out under which 7 vocational educational schools were requested to give presentations on experience acquired by 24 vocational education teachers while studying abroad. The presentations demonstrate experience the teachers gained and activities they performed overseas.

In cooperation with the EU project, the VET state development program has been included in the working group activities, which aims to bring under the issue of teachers international mobility in the vocational education internationalization concept. The questionnaire was developed for schools to identify the current situation in educational schools in terms of international mobility for the so-called "baseline" research. After the concept elaboration, the training module on the international mobility has been developed in cooperation with the EU project.

Fifty vocational education teachers have been trained in international mobility issues and awarded with certificates.

With the UNDP support, a working meeting was held to develop the policy document. "VET development, induction and development policy document" has been prepared and drawn up.

With the UNDP support, the training module "Modular teaching issues for inductee teachers" has been developed and **28 teachers trained**.
